POLICY

Aurora College welcomes applications from qualified Canadian and international applicants.

PRINCIPLES

1. Aurora College recognizes that a global outlook to education is a benefit to the College and its communities.
2. The College is cognizant of its responsibility to offer Northern residents access to College Programs.
3. The College believes that its programs are unique in their inclusion of Northern geography, culture, traditions, and lifestyle.
4. Non-resident students, with their diverse backgrounds and learning experiences, will enrich the education of resident students and community.

PROCEDURES

1. The admission of Canadian applicants will be limited by the maximum student capacity of the program and the number of qualified applications received from the NWT residents.
2. The admission of international applicants will be limited by the maximum student capacity of the program and the number of qualified applications received from Canada.
3. For any programs which are developed specifically for non-resident students, admission criteria will be published in the appropriate program documents.
4. An individual who has a student visa, landed immigrant status, or Canadian citizenship may be considered for admission to Aurora College subject to the above limitations.
