POLICY

A College Honour Roll shall be established for Certificate, Diploma, and Degree programs.

PRINCIPLES

1. Aurora College recognizes the importance of acknowledging students' academic excellence.
2. Exemplary academic achievement shall be recognized as a way of contributing to the tradition of excellence at the College.

PROCEDURES

1. An Honour Roll, with the name of each student recognized for excellence, shall be displayed in a prominent location at each campus and shall be published based on the direction of the President.
2. For a student to be recognized on the annual Honour Roll, the student will meet all of the following criteria:
 - i. completion of a full year of prescribed courses as detailed in the Program Outline;
 - ii. a minimum overall average of eighty percent (80%); and
 - iii. no final course grade below sixty-five percent (65%).
3. The Registrar or designate shall verify that each candidate has met the criteria.
4. The Vice Presidents or designate(s) shall provide a complete list of names for the College Honour Roll to the President who shall table the listing with the Board of Governors.
5. The Vice Presidents shall prepare a letter of acknowledgement to each Honour Roll student and copy the letter to the Registrar for inclusion in the student's permanent file. The letter will only be released when it is confirmed that the student is in good financial standing with the College.
