

AURORA COLLEGE

POLICY

Aurora College may offer programming and services to individuals who are less than seventeen years of age.

PRINCIPLES

1. For some young people, enrolment in courses and programs offered by the College may be beneficial to their academic development and achievement.
2. The College may supplement secondary school programming through joint programming.

PROCEDURES

1. The appropriate College Vice President or Director shall approve, in writing, any programming that may include underage students.
2. Any underage student applying for admission into an Aurora College program or course shall include written consent from a parent or legal guardian and a release form from the school, if applicable.
3. The applicant shall submit full tuition upon his/her registration into such a program/course.
