AURORA COLLEGE

POLICY

Aurora College shall assign credit to courses that are part of Certificate, Diploma, Post Diploma, Advanced Diplomas, and Applied Degree programs.

PRINCIPLES

- 1. Aurora College recognizes the need for credit to validate Certificate, Diploma, Post Diploma, Advanced Diploma, and Applied Degree programs.
- 2. The College Document of Recognition for Certificate, Diploma, Post Diploma and Advanced Diploma programs is awarded based upon the successful completion of a required number of credit courses and related learning experiences.
- 3. The College Document of Recognition for Applied Degree programs is awarded based upon the successful completion of a required number of credit courses and the completion of appropriate work experience components/courses.
- 4. The College recognizes that the assignment of credits to a course is one part of the process that allows Aurora College to enter into articulation agreements with other post-secondary institutions.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Assignment of credit shall be given on the basis of instructional contact hours with fifteen (15) hours equivalent to one (1) credit.
- 2. The College will grant credit in a Certificate/Diploma/Post Diploma/Advanced Diploma/Applied Degree Program to a student who successfully completed a standard 3-credit course that has 45 hours of delivery.
- 3. The College will grant a College Certificate to a student who completes a minimum of thirty (30) credits in a Certificate Program or as otherwise stated in the Program Outline.
- 4. The College will grant a College Diploma to a student who completes a minimum of sixty (60) credits in a Diploma Program, or as otherwise stated in the Program Outline.
- 5. The College will grant a College Post Diploma or and Advanced Diploma to a student who completes a minimum of thirty (30) credits in a Post Diploma Program or Advanced Diploma Program, or as otherwise stated in the Program Outline.

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For students who have not completed the relevant pre-requisite diploma from Aurora College or have not received a related and recognized diploma from an accredited institution, successful completion of a Post Diploma or Advance Diploma program will require ninety (90) credits and completion of all work experience components and/or courses as stated in the Program outline.

6. Subject to ministerial approval of the program, the College will grant an Applied Degree to a student who completes thirty (30) credits at the post-diploma level and completes all work experience components/courses as stated in the Program outline.

For students who have not completed the relevant pre-requisite diploma from Aurora College or have not received a related and recognized diploma from an accredited institution, successful completion of a Post Diploma or Advance Diploma program will require ninety (90) credits and completion of all work experience components and/or courses as stated in the Program outline.

7. Any exception to #2 and #3 will be presented to the Board of Governors who will approve/reject the change. Exceptions will be stated in the calendar and in the program outline.
