AURORA COLLEGE

POLICY

Aurora College shall develop and maintain a process for regular program and course review and update.

PRINCIPLES

- 1. Aurora College is committed to maintain high standards of educational excellence.
- 2. The College recognizes that post-secondary learning takes place in an increasingly complex world where knowledge increases at a rapid pace and that College programs and courses reflect these changes.
- 3. College program and course content must be consistently and regularly revised to ensure a student has the opportunity to learn the latest theories and skills.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Aurora College will ensure that programs and courses are reviewed and updated on an annual basis.
- 2. The process, described in Policy B.15 Establishment of New Course (numbers 1-5), will be followed in the amending of course outlines.
- 3. If the course revision is less than 20%, the procedure in B.15 does not apply. The Director recommends the revision to the Director, Policy and Programs.
- 4. The process described in Policy B.13 (#1 7) will be followed in the amending of Program Outlines.
- 5. If the Program revision is less than 20%, the procedure in B.13 does not apply. The President must approve the revision.

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
