

POLICY

Aurora College does not rent or lend out Heavy Equipment except in emergency or exceptional situations.

PRINCIPLES

- 1. Aurora College is a post-secondary educational institution; the operational requirements of its programs are its first priority.
- 2. The use of College equipment by other agencies must not interfere with private enterprise in the community.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all Heavy Equipment owned by Aurora College.

DEFINITIONS

Emergency: A present or imminent event that is affecting or could affect the health, safety or welfare of people or is damaging or could damage property (*Civil Emergency Measures Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988,c.C-9,s.1)

Heavy Equipment: Heavy-duty vehicles that are specifically designed to do construction tasks, usually involving earthmoving.

1.0 GENERAL

1.1 In emergency or exceptional situations the President has the authority to authorize the use of Aurora College Heavy Equipment by qualified operators when requested by a government agency.
