AURORA COLLEGE

POLICY

Aurora College shall provide access to instructional equipment for instructional purposes.

PRINCIPLES

- 1. The College believes in supporting quality programs and services with resources, including instructional equipment.
- 2. Students will be treated fairly and equally regarding access to instructional equipment needed to complete their programs/courses.
- 3. Access to the use of College instructional equipment is an earned privilege.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Approval will be given by the Director or designate before use of the instructional equipment is allowed. Priority of use is as follows:
 - a) course instruction
 - b) student use
 - c) staff use
 - d) authorized personnel
- 2. Any person using the instructional equipment will comply with the rules for instructional equipment usage.
- 3. The Director is responsible for publishing the Campus Protocol.
- 4. Students, staff and authorized personnel with prior authorization may gain access to instructional equipment outside regularly scheduled, supervised classes subject to approval by the Director or designate.
- 5. Instructional equipment may not be removed from the College property without the permission of the Director or designate.
