What class of driver’s licence do I need to drive an Aurora College passenger vehicle?

Class of Licence Required	Aurora College Passenger Vehicles	Location
Class 1	n/a	n/a
Class 2	n/a	n/a
Class 3	n/a	n/a
Class 4	Ford E350 Van (12 passenger) Ford Transit Van	Fort Smith Inuvik
Class 5	Cars (Explorer, Focus, Taurus, Windstar) Small Trucks (F150, F250, F350, GMC truck, Chevy Suburban)	There are assorted cars and small trucks at the campuses and some of the learning centres.

Summary of passenger vehicles one can drive as determined by class of driver’s licence.

Class 1 – Any vehicle in classes 2-5

Class 2 – A bus of any seating capacity of passengers; any vehicles in classes 3-5

Class 3 – A single vehicle with three or more axles; any vehicles in classes 4-5

Class 4 – Buses that carry fewer than 24 passengers; taxis; ambulances; any vehicle in class 5

Class 5 – Cars, small trucks – with two axles only

Class 6 – motorcycles; any vehicle in class 5 while learning to operate it

Class 7 – any vehicle in classes 5 and 6 while learning to operate it
